Updated MMSEA Section 111 User Guide Issued

On October 1, 2018 the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) published a new user guide for entities in the Non Group Health Plan (NGHP) category, regarding Section 111 Mandatory Insurance Reporting under the Medicare Secondary Payer Act's (MSP) amendment called the Medicare,

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Medicaid, and SCHIP Extension Act of 2007 (MMSEA).

New Section 111 Reporting User Guide Published by CMS (But ...

MMSEA Section 111 User Guide, Version 5.6, July 1, 2019 Chapter II (Registration Procedures), Section 4.2.2: CMS has added clarification that Responsible Reporting Entities (RRE) should submit one Claim Input file per quarter. However, also noted in the guide, is mention that CMS will still accept multiple Claim Input Files per quarter.

Pursuant to Section 111 of the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Extension Act of 2007 (MMSEA Section 111), the new mandatory reporting requirements apply to Group Health Plans that provide coverage to Medicare beneficiaries, as well as to liability insurance providers (including self-insurance), no-fault insurance, and workers' compensation plans that pay settlements, judgments, awards or other payments to Medicare beneficiaries.

MMSEA Section 111 Mandatory Reporting: A Guide to the User ...

Last week the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) issued version 4.3 of its MMSEA Section 111 NGHP User Guide which can be accessed through this link. These changes were primarily driven by Congressional enactment of PAMA on April 1, 2014 which prohibits CMS from using ICD-10 codes on or before October 1, 2015.
