Three-Digit Interstate Freeways. Three-digit highways connect to other major interstates. For example, 405 is a highway that is connected to I-5, while 215 is off I-15.

In the United States, exit numbers are assigned to freeway junctions, and are usually numbered as exits from freeways. Exit numbers generally are found above the destinations (and route number(s)) of the exit, as well as a sign in the gore. Exit numbers typically reset at political borders such as state lines. Some major streets also use exit numbers.

There are 70 primary Interstate Highways in the Interstate Highway System, a network of controlled-access freeways in the United States. They are assigned one- or two-digit route numbers, whereas their associated "auxiliary" Interstate Highways receive three-digit route numbers. Typically, odd-numbered Interstates run south-north, with lower numbers in the west and higher numbers in the east; even-numbered Interstates run west-east, with lower numbers in the south and higher numbers in the north

U.S. Highway Numbering

Other numbered highways with two numbers will tend to run between a few states, but their numberings will not tend to have any pattern. Auxiliary spur routes that deviate from the parent route but will return later will be given a 3rd number at the beginning. This third number will tend to be even.

However, the numbers follow a grid, with rules nobody told me (image source, click to enlarge): Even numbers go East/West (I-90, I-10), and odd numbers go North/South (I-5, I-95). Think "Even" goes "East". Numbers increase towards the Northeast.

Los Angeles Freeway Names

Each route in the State Highway System is given a unique number for identification and signed with distinctive numbered Interstate, U.S. or California State route shields to guide public travel. Route numbers used on one system are not duplicated on another system. Routes are also numbered with post miles, and (coming soon to your neighborhood) freeways are numbered with exit numbers.

Although the transition was gradual - numbers only eclipsed names in common usage in the late 1970s, and Caltrans still included the old names in signage through the 1990s - Southern Californians eventually joined the rest of North America in referring to freeways by number.

A dozen major freeways that span hundreds of miles connect the various regions of L.A. When locals give directions, they usually refer to a freeway only by its number and the word "the," e.g. "Take the 405 to the 10" instead of "Take the San Diego Freeway to the Santa Monica Freeway."
