Ready to Read student texts are crafted and levelled to ensure that students are presented with continual and appropriate challenges. The colour wheel indicates the level of each student text. All of the levels, except Magenta, are further divided into sub-levels to allow for a flatter gradient of text difficulty.

What the guided reading with non-readers lesson cycle should look like. When it comes to a guided reading lesson outline, I like what Jan Richardson suggests in her book *The Next Step in Guided Reading*. Unknowingly, this is roughly what I have followed since I first started teaching in 2008. She suggests the following 4 areas of focus.
